Application file Explanatory note 2024-2025

This explanatory note is intended to help you with the administrative process of applying for a scholarship.

Please read it carefully and entirely before starting the application process.

<u>1.</u> The French Government Scholarships (BGF) co-funded by the ministry of Education, Youth and Sports (MoYES)

This program is open to Ph.D. students.

- **The co-funded scholarship** covers the followings:
- Your daily expenses thanks to a monthly allowance (1 588 € in Ph. D.);
- A round-trip airplane ticket from Cambodia to France;

- Your tuition fees in a public French university or tuition fees up to 5000€/year for the private's ones;

- Your health insurance (medical expenses reimbursed by the French government if you have a health issue);

- A priority access to government subsidized student housing¹;
- The "scholarship older student status" which will give you many discounts in France;
- A repatriation insurance.

Only applications in Sciences, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) fields will be accepted.

This program is for students wishing to come back to work in Cambodia as university teachers and researchers after their PhD.

2. French Government Scholarships duration

The French Government Scholarships duration is as following:

Ph.D. 6 months per year over 3 years of thesis (18 months total)

The 18 months scholarship repartition must be decided over the 3 years of the Ph.D. by the students together with their thesis direction.

¹ Being a French Government Scholarship awardee helps accessing student housing subsidized by the government. Nonetheless, we cannot guarantee to all students their placement in such facilities. Housing remains students' responsibility!

Please note that only PhD students under joint supervision can stay in France less than 6 months. The joint supervision agreement must contain a thesis calendar.

3. Eligibility criteria

Before applying, candidates must verify that they meet the BGF eligibility criteria below:

- 1. To submit a complete application file
- 2. To be a Cambodian national;

3. To have at least a master's degree at the time of departure (September 2024);

4. For applications in French taught programs, good French language proficiency is required. Students will be asked to provide an <u>official</u> **DELF B2** diploma, or to have received a French higher education diploma (baccalaureate, bachelor or master taught in French).

ATTENTION: if you are taking the March 2024 DELF exam, you will have up until **June 30, 2024**, to submit your results to the Embassy;

5. For applications in English taught programs, good English language proficiency is required. Students will be asked to provide an <u>official</u> English certification, such as the IELTS, or to have received a French higher education diploma (baccalaureate, bachelor or master taught in English). The level required has to be equivalent or superior to the B2 level of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (see the table in the next section);

6. Have a research project and a research supervisor in France.

7. To have started the registration and diploma equivalence requests processes with the intended French university;

8. To be willing to come back working for a university in Cambodia after the PhD.

• Candidates must provide a commitment letter from a Cambodian higher education institution for employment after PhD;

• Once awardees are selected: commitment will be formalized with the MoYES;

9. For a civil servant: to have the hierarchy's agreement to pursue a Ph.D. abroad.

Note: for equal marks, female applicants will be encouraged to apply

ATTENTION: The French Government Scholarship application and the application to a French university are two different processes. Each applicant is responsible for :

• their administrative registration in the French university they wish to join and finding a thesis director;

their French Government Scholarship application;

• their registration on the Etudes en France platform.

Applications not meeting the eligibility criteria will not be considered

4. Documents to attach with the application

A complete application file is made of:

0. The application form (a sample, duly completed, is enclosed in annex);

1. The applicant's Curriculum Vitae (CV);

2. A copy of the candidate's passport or ID card;

3. A cover letter, in French or in English, depending on the language chosen for the studies in France, clearly stating the applicant's study project in France and their professional project after the completion of their curriculum in France (1 single-sided page maximum);

4. The applicant's registration certificate in their intended French university and laboratory (or, if not possible, an email exchange with the French university explaining the current state of the application process);

5. The PhD schedule with the planned periods for work in France and in Cambodia (including thesis defense date);

6. Certified copies of all diplomas and transcripts since high school graduation;

7. a 3 to 5 pages research abstract;

8. a letter from their thesis supervisors stating and justifying the wished scholarship duration over the 3 years of thesis;

9. **For French taught programs:** a DELF B2 diploma;

10. **For English taught programs:** an English B2 level diploma²;

11. Commitment letter from a Cambodian higher education institution for employment after PhD;

12. **For all students:** the current Cambodian university's registration certificate;

13. **For civil servants**: a letter from their hierarchy agreeing to their studying abroad.

14. Creation of the Etudes en France file (please create an account and fill in all the requested information) This procedure is not free of charge but is mandatory for the registration process: https://pastel.diplomatie.gouv.fr/etudesenfrance/dyn/public/authentification/login.html

<u>Note</u>: optional recommendation letters can be added to the file.

Applicants will not have to provide a French DELF B2 diploma if:

- they have a French baccalaureate, Bachelor or master degree taught in French;

- they want to follow an English taught program (they will then have to provide an English proficiency certification equivalent to a Common European Framework of Reference for Languages B2 level, or a French bachelor or master degree taught in English).

Incomplete files will not be considered

File submission

The form and all the attached documents shall be submitted to the Cooperation and Cultural action department of the Embassy of France in Cambodia.

Submissions have to be made by e-mail at the Embassy of France campusfrance@institutfrancais-cambodge.com

Please note that this procedure does not replace the mandatory registration to the Etudes en France platform. In order to be eligible for this scholarship, you will also have to fill in all the information on the platform and submit the requested documents. The submission deadline is: January 19, 2024 at 6pm

5. Applicants assessment process and results proclamation

Following your registration on the Etudes en France platform, you will be invited to an individual interview at the Espace Campus France in Phnom Penh with the Campus France Manager.

After reviewing all the applications, the best candidates will be invited at the Embassy (or via skype) for an interview.

If you're not invited to an interview at the end of March 2024, you can consider that your application hasn't been selected.

Then, the final selection of the 2024 French government Scholarship awardees shall be made by a jury of scholars and specialists of the candidates' fields of study. This jury will gather in April, 2024. Its decision will be based both on the quality of the application file and on the applicant's oral performance on the day of the interview.

Results shall be published mid-May, 2024, on the Embassy's website: <u>www.ambafrance-kh.org</u> and on Campus France Cambodge's website: <u>www.cambodge.campusfrance.org</u>

ATTENTION: Please note that no scholarship will be considered as definitively awarded so long as all documents and certifications have not been submitted. In particular: bachelors, masters, French university registrations and language certifications obtained after the 23rd of March will have to be submitted to the Embassy before the launch of the scholarship.
